What is the purpose of your charity?

The Food Bank of the Rio Grande Valley continues to respond to the effects of Covid-19, historic high inflation, and the daily crisis of hunger. As our Mission Statement continues to affirm, we are passionately committed to improving lives through: food assistance, nutrition education, and equitable access to community services.

The Food Bank RGV has been providing free emergency food assistance since its inception in 1986. We are currently feeding up to 76,000 individuals on a weekly basis via our Partner Agencies and community partners. The majority of our programs assist low-income households, seniors, veterans, and those recovering from the effects of Covid-19 and inflation.

With your funding we can immediately distribute 52,632 pounds of emergency food via the Pharr Resource Center and Mission Resource Center to at least 2,832 low-income and/or food insecure families living within Cameron, Hidalgo, or Willacy counties. The total poundage of 52,632 is equivalent to 43,860 meals within 12 months of funding.
